It does not seem possible that we are at the end of February and Easter is just around the corner. The date of Easter moves each year which can catch us all out—in case you wondered Easter Day is the first Sunday after the full moon which appears on or after the spring equinox. The equinox is the 21st March so the earliest Easter can be is the 22nd March and the latest is the 25th April. We have one of the early ones this year on the 31st March.

We are very grateful to our Baptist friends who are kindly offering us the use of their church on Back Walls pending our repairs to the heating system in St Edward's. There will be a service at Stow Baptist Church on Good Friday at 2 pm and at 11 am on Easter Day. We will also have an Easter Eve service at Condicote and an Easter Day service at Lower Swell.
